Being told only 5 spaces available (4 for Bilal's brothers)

We are short 5+9 spaces

Pictou Safe Harbour selected top family (1 out of 3 family application)

# Agenda Item: YReach school support worker

#### Discussion:

Background: In April, Anuj, Jack, Maria, and Karen met with YReach staff Setsu Kawahara (YMCA Provincial Small Centre Supervisor) and Trina Samson (YReach Settlement Coordinator) about the school support position and the LINC (Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada) centre coming to Antigonish. LINC funded by IRCC and will offer year-round 1-6 level instruction. 80% attendance expectation. 3-6 months after receiving citizenship, newcomers no longer eligible for teaching. 2 instructors. Looking for space.

Mary Larkin (School Support worker) and Trina attended our board meeting

Mary works with all newcomer children and families to have a PR application in process. Her position runs September to June. She explained that she has accompanied Syrian parents to parent teacher meetings in all schools, and is trying to get children into town and county summer camps. Day care crisis (very long waits to get in) has made camps very important. Working with Maria around getting dental care for families

Jack said he had booked library space for Syrian students to keep learning over the summer

Mark reported they had sought money from YReach to have a daycare in the mosque. SAFE told money all gone

Board suggested we add a question about help from school support worker on our family check-in form

Board concern that SAFE could be blocked through confidentiality as YReach gets into the schools. Concern province-wide that language assessments become more rigid. Concern about bigger picture of how language learning is being organized for newcomers

Mark will notify Trina that Jack will be SAFE's contact person with Mary Larkin.

Jack requested of YReach staff that SAFE get a timely response to questions about families and services
